In the District of Columbia, neighborhoods may apply to become historic districts in order to manage change. The designation mainly preserves the character of the front street scape and prevents demolition of sound structures. (Note: DC Historic Districts do not entail the restrictions or approvals of Federal Historic Districts such as Georgetown.)
